PRACTICALITIES

A preliminary discussion will establish your goals, the appropriate level of investment and your wine preferences.

The recommended monthly payment is £50–£150 to build a drinking cellar. If you are looking to build an "investment" cellar we recommend a minimum monthly payment of £250 or more.

Many people invest a one-off lump sum to get their cellar off to a flying start. This would allow the purchase of some older or higher value wines.

You can be as involved or as "hands-off" as you want in the selection of your wines.

Then there is very little for you to do other than review your cellar online and, once your wines are ready to drink, decide when to take delivery of and enjoy your wines.

Storage costs at Private Reserves Ltd. are £11.25 ex VAT (£13.50 inc VAT) per 12pk and £5.62 ex VAT (£6.75 inc VAT) per 6pk per annum.

Prosecco

**PROSECCO SUPERIORE EXTRA DRY
CONEGLIANO VALDOBBIADENE BIANCA VIGNA**

We have been working with Elena and Luca at Bianca Vigna for many years and the quality of their Prosecco has ensured this has become a reliable Goedhuis favourite. Soft and creamy with notes of fresh almond, pear and apple, it is refined and pure, everything a good Prosecco should be.

House Champagne

CHAMPAGNE PAUL GOERG BRUT RÉSERVE NV
£149.00/6 bts £24.83/bt

After a long search we selected Paul Georg as our house Champagne in 2015, and continue to be delighted with their approachable, expressive style of wine. This fine blend of 60% Chardonnay and 40% Pinot Noir benefits from three years in bottle before release, which allows the Chardonnay time to evolve. Pale lemon colour, with aromas of brioche and a creamy citrus freshness on the palate. It is an excellent all-round Champagne.

**CHAMPAGNE PAUL GOERG PREMIER CRU
BLANC DE BLANCS NV**

This 100% Chardonnay sourced from the premier cru vineyards around Vertus in the Côte des Blancs is a step up in refinement and complexity and shows off the Goerg group's skill in the cellar. Brilliant pale lemon yellow with a fine, persistent mousse. Classical Blanc de Blancs characteristics of citrus, orchard fruit, and brioche fill the glass. The base of the blend is 2009, and the palate has a satisfying creamy texture. This modestly priced Blanc de Blancs offers length, breadth and complexity.

Non-Vintage Champagne

LOUIS ROEDERER BRUT PREMIER NV

£222.00/6 bts £37.00/bt

This acclaimed Champagne house remains a family run operation, and consistently delivers one of the very best non-vintage blends, with a high proportion of Pinot Noir (40% Pinot Noir, 40% Chardonnay, 20% Pinot Meunier). The Champagne has a rich, creamy texture with a lovely lemony finish. A small proportion is matured in oak cask, and the wine spends three years on lees before disgorgement. This ageing process, combined with a good proportion of reserve wine in the final blend, gives this wine excellent complexity and definition. This is a sumptuous, plush style of Champagne.

POL ROGER WHITE FOIL BRUT NV

Pol Roger's non-vintage blend is hard to beat, and it quite rightly has a huge following. This lively, appealing NV is Chardonnay dominated and consistently brilliant. Three years' ageing adds complexity, and the wine has wonderfully creamy bubbles. Delicate biscuit warmth with the crunch of autumnal orchard fruits give definition to the tasty but refined palate. Fresh, elegant and hugely enjoyable.

RUINART BLANC DE BLANCS NV

£310.00/6 bts £51.67/bt

Indisputably one of the great Chardonnay houses of Champagne, Ruinart are kings of Blanc de Blancs. Their iconic non-vintage is a gleaming yellow with flecks of lime green. The nose is emphatically fresh with pure citrus fruit aromas. This is a delicious Champagne with a delicate mousse and a charming display of stone fruits. It is impeccably elegant.

Rosé Champagne

BILLECART SALMON BRUT ROSÉ NV

£348.00/6 bts £58.00/bt

The most elegant of all pink Champagnes, this is everything that a great rosé should be. The delicate colour is accompanied by fragrant aromas of strawberries and red currants. The palate echoes these summer fruit flavours, carried along by crisp acidity. This is the best NV rosé in the market.

Vintage Champagne

MOËT & CHANDON GRAND VINTAGE 2008

£267.00/6 bts £44.50/bt

2008 is fast proving itself as one of the great Champagne vintages of recent decades. Moët's 2008 offers the vintage's hallmark appeal at an affordable price. Citrus and honeysuckle notes along with freshly baked pastries on the nose. Invitingly fresh, it is beginning to show graceful evolution. The palate leads into creamy notes of brioche, toasted nuts and honey, with touches of smoky minerality. It possesses both powerful fruit and scintillating acidity.

POL ROGER BRUT VINTAGE 2009

£360.00/6 bts £60.00/bt

NEW

60% Pinot Noir, 40% Chardonnay sourced from 20 grand and premier cru vineyards in the Montagne de Reims and the Côte des Blancs. Produced in limited quantities and aged for 8 years in the cellar before disgorgement. This 2009 is lively and energetic with aromas of delicate white peach followed by a juicy apricot palate. There is wonderful harmony between the stone fruit flavours, the dancing freshness, and the complex notes of brioche coming from the wine's long ageing. It is at once opulent, creamy and lively.

TAITTINGER COMTES DE CHAMPAGNE BLANC DE BLANCS 2007

NEW

The nose is beautifully delicate and very fresh. Notes of citrus, white blossom, golden raisins, and fresh biscuits. The palate has a gorgeous vibrancy and youthful elegance; lots of tense energy. As it opens notes of lemons, citrus zest, velvety white peach intermingled with some biscuit spice and creamy salted butter layer your palate. There is a seam of mouth-watering mineral salinity which leaves a bright refreshing finish. In short, this is as exceptional as any top class Grand Cru white Burgundy.

DOM PÉRIGNON VINTAGE 2009

£698.00/6 bts £116.33/bt

The seductive 2009 Dom Pérignon has become a firm favourite with the Goedhuis team. Marked out by its open expression and its fresh mineral nose of oyster shell and smoky gun flint. The palate is exquisite, with profound depth of flavour and a vibrant saline finish. Its power, aromatic persistence, and silky texture are simply irresistible.

WHITE

CRISP, MINERAL & ZESTY

In this chapter we take you on a "Grand Tour" of the white wine producing regions of Europe, through a wealth of captivating grape varieties.

The cool climate vineyards of France are well-represented. Sauvignon Blanc comes from Sancerre and Pouilly Fumé, the great appellations of the Loire, and also features in a white Bordeaux blend. We find pure, unoaked Chardonnay from Chablis, St Véran and south west France, while the juicy ripe fruit of our flagship Goedhuis Bourgogne Blanc is tempered by the lightest touch of oak.

Across into Austria we have a new addition in the shape of a deliciously peppery Grüner Veltliner from award-winning Weingut Allram. Journeying south an Albariño from the Atlantic coast in north west Spain and trio of indigenous Italian whites – Vernaccia, Verdicchio and Soave – round off the selection. What these wines share are gorgeous aromatic primary fruit flavours, mineral drive and a lovely lick of crisp acidity on the finish. They are made for drinking young and fresh, so don't delay...

Loire

MUSCADET DE SÈVRE ET MAINE SUR LIE DOMAINE MÉNARD GABORIT 2017

NEW

£54.00/6 bts £9.00/bt

Muscadet has seen quality improve in leaps and bounds recently and is rightly regaining ground as a go-to region for brilliant value, interesting, light whites. This charming wine is pale lemon yellow in the glass and has a touch of creamy lees ageing on the nose. The palate has a vibrant texture with crisp acidity and a lemon pith and peach character. Light in body, but not in flavour.

POUILLY FUMÉ TRADITION DES LOGES MARC DESCHAMPS 2017

Marc Deschamps has a knack for making mineral, textured, grippy Pouilly Fumé. Classical Pouilly flinty notes accompany the green, lime-zesty edge of Sauvignon Blanc. The 2017 is textured and long.

SANCERRE DOMAINE BERNARD REVERDY 2017

£174.00/12 bts £14.50/bt

Romain Reverdy has made a wonderful Sancerre in 2017. His vines around the village of Verdigny enjoyed an excellent growing season, which ensured good phenolic ripeness whilst retaining Sancerre's signature nervous acidity. This wine has a pretty floral elegance, creamy texture, and brisk mineral tension.

POUILLY FUMÉ PETIT F MICHEL REDDE ET FILS 2017

£180.00/12 bts £15.00/bt

This cuvée is made from young Sauvignon Blanc vines grown on the flinty limestone soils of Pouilly Fumé in the Loire Valley. The 2017 is so delicate and refined, and its complex, restrained aroma of lemon verbena and salty sea spray help it transcend its varietal character. This is precisely balanced on the mid-palate with a long, fresh, diamond-cut finish. Made by the enterprising Sébastien Redde, an emerging talent of the region.

SANCERRE ANDRÉ DEZAT 2017

£186.00/12 bts £15.50/bt

The Dezats have parcels scattered around the village of Verdigny in the heart of the appellation, and they have a long tradition of producing one single blend from them all. Their 2017 has a pale lemon colour and a lightly floral orange blossom scent with a twist of fresh citrus. The palate has a refreshing chalky texture and shows the vintage's attractive ripeness with Sancerre's classical crisp freshness.

Burgundy

ST VÉРАН DOMAINE DE LA CROIX SENAILLET 2016
£87.00/6 bts £14.50/bt

In a relatively short time the Martin family have established themselves as one of the finest domaines in the Maconnais village of Davayé. This St Véran is a pretty wine with oyster shell and citrus aromas matched by creamy fruit flavours, some bright acidity, and a smoky background. A good all-round white.

CHABLIS CHARLÈNE ET LAURENT PINSON 2015 NEW
£180.00/12 bts £15.00/bt

From enterprising father and daughter winemaking team Laurent and Charlène Pinson in the heart of Chablis. A typically green apple and lime pith aroma of classical village Chablis on the nose is followed by 2015's natural ripeness and generosity on the palate, making this an exceptionally satisfying glass of Chablis.

BOURGOGNE CHARDONNAY GOEDHUIS & CO 2015 G
£189.00/12 bts £15.75/bt

This Bourgogne Blanc has been specially vinified for us by one of Meursault's most acclaimed growers, Jean-Philippe Fichet. He has been making this excellent cuvée for us since 2013, and the 2015 is the best yet. It offers the ripe, accessible, juicy nature of the 2015 vintage with classical Côte de Beaune tension and length, at a great price.

CHABLIS BILLAUD-SIMON 2016 NEW
£114.00/6 bts £19.00/bt G

This is a charming and open style of Chablis, with the peachy roundness of 2015 combined with the acidity and freshness seen in 2014. A great all-rounder. Domaine fruit has been supplemented with some purchased grapes to make up for the severe losses of the April frost.

BOURGOGNE VIEILLES VIGNES JEAN-PHILIPPE FICHET 2015
£258.00/12 bts £21.50/bt

Jean-Philippe's painstaking attention to detail is demonstrated in all his wines, which are pure and seamless. This old vine Bourgogne Blanc has delicate aromas of white peach and lemon zest. Driven, mineral and fresh on the palate, this is all about finesse.

South-West France

CHARDONNAY VIN DE PAYS D'OC DOMAINE BEGUDE 2018 NEW
£114.00/12 bts £9.50/bt (available from March 2019)

An excellent value unoaked Chardonnay, from a lovely estate near Limoux in the South West of France. This is a light, stone fruit and citrus scented dry white. Easy drinking and refreshing, with peachy, apricot flavours on the palate.

CH LA FORÊT ENTRE-DEUX-MERS 2017 NEW
£126.00/12 bts £10.50/bt

A blend of Sauvignon Blanc with some Sémillon, Muscadelle and Sauvignon Gris, from the limestone and gravel soils of Bordeaux's Entre-Deux-Mers. A short period of skin contact gives this wine texture and a waxy concentration, whilst the Sauvignon and Sémillon proffer their lemony, white peach scent. It has a quenching citrus-edged finish.

Italy

SOAVE TAMELLINI 2017
£75.00/6 bts £12.50/bt

This is a refreshing and balanced glass of Italian white with the light scent of nettle tea and lemon zest. The Tamellinis have built a reputation from their authentic and classical style of Soave over the past 20 years, and their wines have a creamy, phenolic texture. This gives grip and weight to the palate of this easy and lively Italian white from the Veneto. Uncomplicated, and with a good ripe acidity, it is very easy to enjoy.

VERDICCHIO DEI CASTELLI DI JESI SARTARELLI 2017 NEW
£156.00/12 bts £13.00/bt

Sartarelli are a revered name in the lesser known Italian region of Le Marche, neighbour of Umbria and Tuscany. The picturesque town of Jesi is famous for its deliciously drinkable, fresh and structured Verdicchios, and this one is a beauty. Its ripe aroma of white peaches is combined with a lively freshness on the palate. It is generous and concentrated with flavours of waxy lemons and ripe grapefruit.

VERNACCIA DI SAN GIMIGNANO LE CALCINAIE 2017 NEW
£162.00/12 bts £13.50/bt G

This is a glassful of pure joy. The 2017 from an organic vineyard in Tuscany captures the sunshine and salty freshness of great Vernaccia. It has an expressively aromatic nose, with a peach, lemon pith and white flower aroma. The palate has zesty freshness and energy. This estate has excelled in 2017.

Austria

GRÜNER VELTLINER HASEL KAMPTAL ALLRAM 2016
£93.00/6 bts £15.50/bt

This spicy Gruner Veltliner is a really exciting new addition to our list. The Hasel vineyard's loess soils protect the vines from drought stress and its gentle south-facing slopes promote the perfect ripening of Austria's finest white variety. It has an inviting aroma of stone fruit and peppery rocket. The palate has excellent weight and texture, kept refreshed by its vibrant acidity and the light, salty vein running through it.

Spain

ALBARIÑO RÍAS BAIXAS BODEGAS LAGAR DE CERVERA 2016
£192.00/12 bts £16.00/bt

The cool region of Rías Baixas in Spain's north west corner is home to these energetic, versatile wines. With lightly aromatic notes of peach and salty freshness, this Albariño is an excellent match with fish dishes. The palate is zingy, with the arresting freshness of juiced limes.

WHITE

ROUND & FULLER BODIED

This chapter celebrates one of the world's most versatile white grape varieties, Chardonnay, from its heartland of Burgundy and further afield.

As Burgundy specialists for over 35 years we are proud to represent many of the greatest growers across the region. The southern appellations of the Côte Chalonnaise and Mâcon offer tremendous value for Burgundy lovers. These wines are approachable, pure and fresh. We also love the steely, mineral intensity of Chablis, whose cool climate produces vibrant stone fruit flavours.

In the villages of St Aubin, Meursault and Puligny Montrachet the Chardonnay grape reaches its most intense and reveals its extraordinary complexity in the glass. Whether you are seeking a bright, textured St Aubin, a rich, broad Meursault or a precise and mineral Puligny, there is a wine here for you.

We are also very excited about our latest addition to this section, a fine expression of New World Chardonnay from Californian producer, Eden Rift Vineyards.

Côte Chalonnaise & Mâcon

MÂCON MONTBELLET MALLORY & BENJAMIN TALMARD 2017 
£132.00/12 bts £11.00/bt

One of our best value drinkers on the list. Peachy, approachable yellow fruit flavours and a bright palate make for a charming wine. This is a *bona fide* Goedhuis favourite, and a wine we have been buying for decades. The 2017 is just the latest example in a long line of delicious, great value white Burgundies from this estate.

MÂCON-LOCHÉ MARCEL COUTURIER 2015
£165.00/12 bts £13.75/bt


Marcel is infectiously enthusiastic about his region and is rightly proud of his 2015s. Zesty tangerine and wonderful ripe pineapple and apricot flavours burst from the glass. It has such an appetising, textured palate, and showcases the high quality attainable in the best sites across the Mâconnais.

POUILLY FUISSÉ VIEILLES VIGNES DOMAINE PARISSÉ 2016
£270.00/12 bts £22.50/bt

The finest vineyards of the Mâconnais are an excellent place to source high quality Chardonnay at reasonable prices. This has a sweetly perfumed stone fruit character, recalling juicy nectarines and white peaches, with floral notes. The 2016 has a fresh, racy lift cutting through the ripe stone fruit flavours.

MERCUREY BLANC CHÂTEAUX DE CHAMIREY 2015 **NEW**

£150.00/3 mags £50.00/mag

This delicious white wine from Château de Chamirey is an excellent example of why the appellation of Mercurey is catching the eye of Burgundy aficionados. It is a lovely lemon yellow colour and has generous aromas of citrus zest, with hints of fresh clotted cream. A natural generosity of fruit is balanced with a fine volume, mouth-coating texture and bright lively finish. A very appealing style, with plenty of layers and depth.

MONTAGNY 1ER CRU VIEUX CHÂTEAU JEAN-MARC BOILLOT 2016 **NEW**

£324.00/6 mags £54.00/mag

Always one of our most popular wines, this comes from a distinguished domaine with extensive holdings in Puligny Montrachet. The Boillots put their winemaking expertise to great effect in the Côte Chalonnaise vineyards of Montagny. A creamy, lightly lemon-scented perfume unfolds into orchard fruit on the easy-drinking palate with a fresh, mineral finish. One of our favourites.



Chablis

CHABLIS JEAN-PAUL DROIN 2015

Benoît Droin is making seriously good Chablis these days. His fanatical dedication in the vineyard results in his consistently producing some of the greatest wines in the appellation each and every vintage. This 2015 is a benchmark example of village Chablis. It is crisp and zesty, with lemon pith and grassy notes. The palate has a bite of acidity to counter the ripe fruit.

CHABLIS 1ER CRU MONTMAIN DOMAINE PINSON FRÈRES 2015

The high clay content of the Montmain soil was an advantage in this warm vintage. It meant the vines had good water reserves and the vineyard remained cool on the hotter days of June and July. It is a tightly coiled style of Chablis premier cru, with just a touch of flinty reduction, and light salinity on the finish.

The *climat* of Troesmes lies within the large premier cru site of Beauroy and has the reputation for making an elegant and refined style of Chablis. ST AUBIN 1ER CRU EN REMILLY MAISON ROCHE DE BELLENE 2016

This famous vineyard sitting on the higher slopes behind Le Montrachet in the commune of St Aubin has a reputation for making bright, energetic wines. MEURSAULT JEAN-PHILIPPE FICHET 2015

Jean-Philippe Fichet's village Meursault comes from several parcels across the appellation and delivers a superb portrait of classic Meursault. The nose is full of tropical fruits, with hints of peach and melon. This graceful wine is subtly opulent, ripe, broad and full on the palate. Superb.

This is an opulent Pomerol hailing from the Moueix stable. At just 5 hectares, this is a small estate in relative Bordelais terms. Twin to the famous Clos René vineyard, this is a blend of 70% Merlot, 20% Cabernet Franc, and 10% Malbec from vines with an average age of 35 years. The warm soils of the Pomerol plateau result in a wine with a firm tannic core supporting a luxurious wave of rich fruit and black tea spice.

The superb quality and seductive appeal of Italian wines is undeniable. Robust savoury flavours, firm acidity and textured tannins make these brilliant food wines. Pull the cork on an intensely perfumed Nebbiolo from Barbaresco or Barolo, an elegant, fruity Chianti or Rosso di Montalcino, or a complex and spicy Brunello.

We have two great Riojas from the excellent 2010 vintage on the list as well: juicy and well-balanced.

Gigondas stands alongside Châteauneuf du Pape as home to the southern Rhône's most complex, densely layered and profound wines. This elegant cuvée from Clos des Cazaux has a lovely intensity that is beginning to unfurl revealing heady red berry fruit of Grenache, and the peppery spice of some supporting Syrah.

CÔTES DU RHÔNE COUDOULET DE BEAUCASTEL PERRIN 2015

From a parcel that lies just beyond the boundary of the Châteauneuf appellation, but is actually an extension of Ch de Beaucastel's single block. After a brief swirl in the glass it begins to open up its notably nuanced layers for a declassified wine. There is a delicate sweetness to the red berry fruit, and a dusting of vanilla and nutmeg spice. The palate is nimble with sleek tannins and a lingering freshness.

CHÂTEAUNEUF DU PAPE DOMAINE DU VIEUX TÉLÉGRAPHE 2012

This is a top class Châteauneuf estate with a well-deserved reputation for long-lived wines. The 60-year-old vines on the stony plateau of La Crau consistently produce a smooth, garrigue-scented Châteauneuf. The sweet, medicinal aromas of bottle-aged Grenache with its macerated strawberry and menthol freshness dominate the nose and follow onto the palate. Its rich fruit is accompanied by grainy tannins and the impressive structure of the wine gives it a long, lasting finish. Drinking well now.

Crozes Hermitage is a large appellation and quality can be variable. This wine has the dark aromas of olive tapenade, with a rich palate displaying peppery, meaty, and dark fruited flavours. It is a cracking new addition to the list.

VIÑA REAL RIOJA RESERVA 2010

This Reserva came out top in our blind tasting of Riojas. It has everything we admire in Rioja: upfront red fruit on the nose, a little spice of oak, and complex savoury flavours on the palate resulting from its 2 years' ageing in barrel. 90% Tempranillo gives it a juicy cherry substance and fine, silky tannins; and the small splash of Garnacha, Graciano, and Mazuelo adds depth and freshness. 2010 is a particularly successful vintage in Rioja, and this example is drinking perfectly now.


CONTINO RIOJA RESERVA CVNE 2010

From the exceptional 2010 vintage, this reserve Rioja is exceptional value for its quality. It is full-bodied and unfurls on the palate with notes of pomegranate, cranberry, red berries, violets and herbs. It has a gorgeous structure and is incredibly drinkable already.

SWEET

Sugar gets a lot of bad press, but sweetness in wine is to be celebrated. Our selection comprises three contrasting regions. The wines of Sauternes derive layered complexity from noble rot. With honeyed citrus flavours and silky texture they are gorgeously sweet yet retain beautiful balance. From the Nahe in Germany, Dönnhoff's Spätlese is delicate and pure, with bright fruit notes. Low in alcohol, this elegant Riesling is vibrant, refreshing and refined.

The list finishes at the other end of the spectrum with a 1985 from legendary Port house, Taylor's. Port is relatively high in alcohol and has delicious natural sweetness. Most importantly, although fully mature at over thirty years old, it is wonderfully alive and encapsulates the essence of great vintage port.
